Snippets from the Ordinary Council Meeting 17 December 2010

Combining the Museum and Tourism Centre in 2011

A Public Meeting was held on the 17 October 2010 with interested members of the public regarding locating the Tourism Officer at the new Museum building for the tourist season. The Shire President concluded that the issues raised would be considered at the December Meeting of Council and the suggestions be discussed fully.

The outcome of these deliberations are as follows:

- a. Transfer the Tourist Information Services from the current location in the Tourist Office to the Mount Magnet Mining and Pastoral Museum for a trial period of the 2011 Tourist Season;
- b. Monitor the impact of the shifting of the services through consultation with local businesses;
- c. Give notice requesting submission from the public, for consideration at the February 2011 meeting, for the future use of the Tourist Information Centre building with the understanding that tourist information services may need to return to the centre if required; and
- d. Liaise with the Tourist Information Centre Inc. when considering any recommendation for the future use of the facility.

A Local Purchasing Policy For the Shire of Mount Magnet

This Policy will give local business the ability to better compete with businesses from larger metropolitan areas. Council's objective is to support the Shire's economic development by ensuring the Shire seeks to source a high level and range of goods and services from local suppliers. Even though Council have always considered this as important, the policy gives clear legal guidelines so that Council decisions cannot be refuted.

Australia Day Celebrations 2011

Council will hold the Citizenship Awards presentation and fireworks at the Recreation Centre on the evening of Tuesday 25 January and a free entertainment and sausage sizzle day at the swimming pool on Wednesday 26 January.

Review of Local Laws

Every Shire has its own Local Laws that deal with the following: Commons Under Land Act; Halls, Buildings; Hall Hire Charges; Prevention of Damage to Streets; Dogs Local Law; Health Local Laws 2002; Standing Orders Local Law 2002; Repeal Local Law 2002; Mount Magnet Public Cemetery Local Law 2002; Activities in Thoroughfares and Public Places and Trading Local Law; Local Government Property Local Law; Bush Fire Brigades Local Law.

The CEO advised that four of these should be repealed and as the last review was done in 2003 a review of all the Local Laws would be applicable. Council decided that a review of the Shire's local laws under s3.16 of the Local Government Act 1995 be commenced.
