Snippets from the Ordinary Council Meeting 27 May 2011

There were quite a few administration agenda items in the May Agenda.

These included:

- ◇ Council passing the Members Fee's and Allowances for 2011-2012,
- ◇ Acceptance of the Chief Executive Officer's Delegated Authorities,
- ◇ Acceptance of the 2009/2010 Annual Report and Council's up coming meeting dates for 2011-2012,
- ◇ A review of the Freedom of Information Document,
- ◇ Consideration to support the Local Government Amendments (Regional Subsidiaries) Bill 2010,
- ◇ Consideration of the Western Australian Local Government Association (WALGA) State Agenda and
- ◇ The selection of Councillors to sit on the State Government initiated, Development Assessment Panel.

Purchase of Back Hoe Loader

A request by the new Works Manager, Mr Bradden Corlett for a Back Hoe Loader to be bought in the new financial year was accepted by Council. The current Bobcat is being used to do tasks such as pushing up tip rubbish, drainage and culvert maintenance and other works. The Bobcat is not the correct plant for these jobs and therefore not as efficient.

VACSWIM

The Department of Education have requested Shire assistance for access to the swimming pool and free pool entry for participants during the VACSWIM classes in summer. Council have agreed to host the VACSWIM program.

Camping Signs at the Granites

It is time to renew the 'No Camping' signs at the Granites in preference for more professional signage. Council will consider setting funds aside in the 2011/2012 budget.

Fee for RV (Recreation Vehicle) Friendly Camping Area

Council has agreed to be a part of the RV Friendly Town concept in an effort to encourage people to stay in town overnight rather than camp out of town. It will help the shire tap into the ever growing Recreational Vehicle tourism phenomena.

Later this year there will be a major RV rally coming through our area and it is hoped that Mount Magnet will be a camping stop for the rally.

Council have fixed a fee of \$5.00 per vehicle to park up overnight.

Tourism Advisory Committee (TAC)

The TAC has not had regular meetings lately but are about to restart on 16 June 2011.

Donation to Cora Munce in the HBF Run For A Reason

In May, Mrs Munce ran ten laps at the Race Course, (15km) in support of the HBF charity run. The money raised will go to Heart Foundation WA. She had collected \$901.70 on her own but had not reached her target of \$1,500. Council agreed to support her efforts and donate \$200.

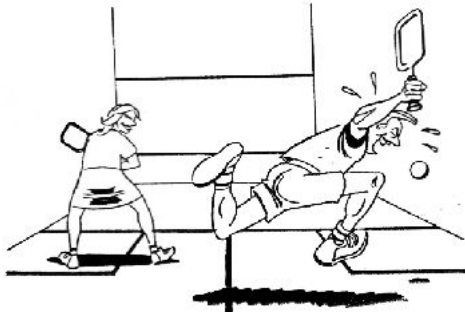
Australia's Biggest Morning Tea — Mount Magnet

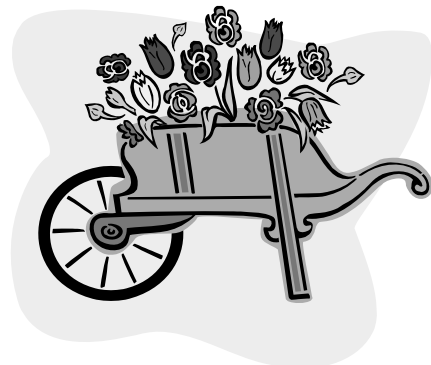
