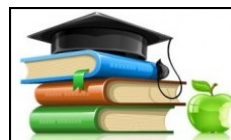

MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

2013 Local Government Elections

Local Government elections are scheduled to take place on 19 October 2013. At these elections there will be six Councillors to be elected to the Shire of Mount Magnet. Nominations for candidates open on Thursday 5 September and close on Thursday 12 September. There is a lot of very useful information relating to standing for Council and the nomination process on the Department of Local Government web site www.dlg.wa.gov.au. In addition Council's CEO Geoff Brooks is also able to provide information and advice to potential candidates.



To be able to vote residents must be on the Electoral Roll which is produced by the Western Australian Electoral Commission. You can check if you are on the Electoral Roll by visiting the Electoral Commission website www.waec.wa.gov.au and entering your details. If you are not on the Electoral Roll enrolment forms are available at the Shire Administration Office and the Post Office. Local Government election enrolments must be lodged and accepted by 5.00pm on Friday 30 August 2013 at the Electoral Commission.

All residents and owners of property in the Shire are encouraged to vote and also to consider standing for Council.

Main Street and Entry Statement Master Plan/ Recreation Precinct Master Plan

In February this year ideas for the Main Street and Recreation Precinct Master Plans were displayed in front of the Post Office and at the Swimming Pool. Many residents commented and put forward suggestions of their own which were much appreciated.

As a result of residents comments and input community planning consultant CCS Strategic has prepared a Master Plan for the Main Street and Entry Statements and also a Master Plan for the Recreation Precinct, which is basically the area around the Recreation Centre.

These Master Plans are available on Council's website and at the Library and Shire Administration Office. Further input from residents is now invited to identify preferred options and priorities. Written comments are invited with a closing date of Friday 2 August or alternatively call in at the Shire and talk to the CEO and staff. They will be happy to run through the plans with you and record your views and suggestions.

The next Ordinary Meeting of Council is scheduled for Friday 2 August 2013 commencing at 1.00pm in Council Chambers. Members of the community are most welcome to attend. At the beginning of the meeting there is an opportunity for residents to ask questions.

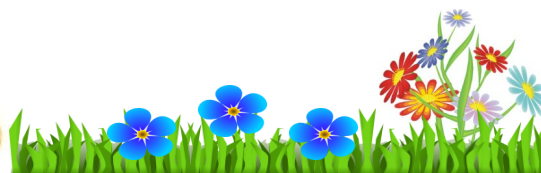
2013 MOUNT MAGNET GARDEN COMPETITION
