

Clean Up Australia Day

The Mount Magnet Clean Up Australia Day event this year attracted 10 children keen to contribute to the appearance of the town. Rubbish was picked up along the full length Hepburn Street, along the Barimaia Creek reserve and also in Watson Street. The children had a great time and enjoyed a swim on completion of their work.



Flood Damage to Roads

On 13 February 2014 advice was received that the Shire of Mount Magnet had been included in the WANDRRA (West Australian Natural Disaster Relief and Recovery Assistance) Notification for a Tropical Low and Associated Flooding event between 16 January 2014 and 6 February 2014 (AGRN606).

This notification opens the way for the provision of funding assistance from both the Federal and State Governments to repair the damaged roads. Recent inspections have revealed that significant damage has been sustained on the Nalbarra/Burnabinmah Road, the Yoweragabbie/Wogarno Road and parts of the Wondinong Road and the Tourist Loop.

This damage will be assessed by Main Roads WA and others in the next few weeks. Based on this assessment claims under the WANDRRA program will be lodged. A key requirement is for the Shire to meet the first \$140,000 of the repairs which it is proposed to fund from Council's 2014/2015 Roads to Recovery program.

Mount Magnet Court House

The State Capital Works Budget in 2013/2014 provided an amount of \$1,500,000 for the construction of a new Court House in Mount Magnet. The previous Court House was closed in 2011 as a result of the poor state of repair of the building. Whilst Council is aware that preliminary plans for the replacement building have been completed the very slow pace of the project is a serious concern.

Approaches are being made to the Attorney General in an effort to make the replacement Mount Magnet Court House a priority project.

The next Ordinary Meeting of Council is scheduled for Friday 4 April 2014 commencing at 1.00pm. Members of the community are most welcome to attend. At the beginning of the meeting there is an opportunity for residents to ask questions.




