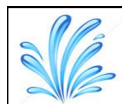

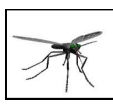

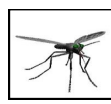

- \* Prohibited Burning Periods - 15 Dec 2014 to 31 Mar 2015 (No open fires).
- \* Restrictive Burning Periods - 1 Apr 2015 to 30 Apr 2015 (Permit required).
- \* Unrestricted Period - 01 May 2015 to 30 Sep 2015 (No permit Required).

## **PROPOSAL TO IMPOSE DIFFERENTIAL AND MINIMUM RATES**

In accordance with section 6.36 of the Local Government Act 1995 notice is hereby given that the Shire of Mount Magnet proposes to differentially rate mining tenements & pastoral holdings in those areas in which unimproved property values apply and urban, commercial and industrial properties & single persons quarters in those areas in which gross rental values apply.

Differential rates and minimum payments proposed for the 2015/2016 financial year are as follows:

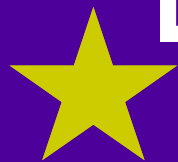
