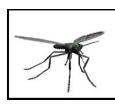

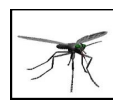

MESSAGE FROM THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER



The Christmas period is nearly upon is and I wish to point out that the Shire Administration Office will be closed from 23 December 2016 until 1 January 2017. There will be a small skeleton staff looking after the gardens and oval.

Something that has come to my attention is the requirement for requests for grants from the Ramelius Community Benefit Fund must be placed before a committee prior to Council considering the request. This committee only meets quarterly on the 3rd Thursday of February, May, August and November and requests must be lodged prior to the last day of the previous month. Any late applications will not be considered.

THIS MEANS PLAN AND APPLY WELL IN ADVANCE OF THE EVENT.

Council is currently calling for quotes for the Swimming Pool Additions and expects to make a decision at its December 2016 meeting with works commencing around the end of March 2016.

Further the Volunteer Fire Brigade running track should commence in the new year as grants have been secured and quotations sought.

Finally, as residents are aware there have been three (3) flag poles erected and we fly the Australian, West Australian and Aboriginal flags each day. Council is seeking a civic minded person to raise and lower the flags each day. Council will consider an honorarium should there be interest. This could be your civic contribution to the Shire.

In closing applications for CEO close on Thursday, 1 December 2016 and it will be interesting to see the application in due course.

October was a busy month for town and ourselves. School holidays saw the movement of people into and around town.

Unfortunately, several burglaries were reported and some offenders have been charged and will appear in court. Please remember to secure your premises and belongings as best as you can, before leaving home or work.

Cue Mount Magnet Magistrates Court was attended twice, with a total of 41 persons appearing before the Magistrate.

We attended to 62 individual tasks, stopped, checked and breathe tested 86 drivers, completed 23 investigations and charged 4 people with a variety of offences.

The weather is warming up and people should remember to keep hydrated, to look after themselves.

With the warmer weather comes bush fires and if reporting a Bush Fire to '000' please remember to supply so many details as possible, to ensure attendance.

Parents are reminded to ensure they have knowledge of where their children are and what they are involved in around town. We attend several calls recently for children on school ground outside of school hours.

No one is permitted on school grounds outside of school hours, unless they are employees of the school.

Several children were spoken too late at night last week and returned home, due to not having suitable supervision. If the same children / parents continue with this, other government agencies may be contacted.

November sees the arrival to town of Senior Constable Adrian McKeown and his family from Perth and soon the departure of 1/C Constable Shanyn Morrison, back to Perth as a Detective.
