Dear Residents,

September has been another steady month for local police with a number of persons charged to court for a range of offences including Assault, Burglary and Possession of Drugs with Intent to Supply.

Illicit Drugs continue to contribute to a substantial number of incidents within the town site, and we are working hard to combat this. With information supplied by the community, we have had some good results this month, and we would encourage anyone with information regarding drug use or drug selling to notify police. This can be done at the station, via telephone call or via Crimestoppers, anonymous and in confidence. It is a community issue, as a community we have to do our best to reduce drug use, we rely upon reliable credible information for intelligence on criminal activity. We are always keen to hear from you and will investigate all good information.

Illicit drugs are not the only contributing factor to incidents in town, alcohol is a factor in most cases too. We are not out to spoil anyone's fun by any means, and we know as well as anybody that after a hard day at work relaxation is needed, but we would encourage you to drink responsibly and know your limits to avoid errors in judgement which can affect your career and life in general.

The summer is fast approaching and the weather is warming up, and with that in mind please remember to keep hydrated and look after yourself. The local pool is now open, and it is an excellent family facility so why not get down there with the kids and wear them out. You never know, it might just give you the five minutes peace and quiet you need to keep you sane!

The first week of school holidays is successfully under our belts with very few incidents of youth anti-social behaviour. We hope this continues and we would remind parents to ensure they have knowledge of where their children are and what they are involved in around town.

With the warmer weather comes the risk of bush fires. If you find yourself in a position where you need to report a Bush Fire to '000', please remember to supply as many details as possible to ensure emergency services can respond appropriately.

#### After School activities

After School Activities programs continue with social football Friday evenings (no football on Friday 6<sup>th</sup> October), and social basketball on a Wednesday. Your local police are continuing to work with other Govt agencies, supported by the Shire of Mount Magnet, Mt Magnet Gold Pty Ltd and IGA, to provide local youth some positive healthy lifestyle programs.




