UNREGISTERED DOGS

The community is advised that the Shire of Mount Magnet has recently collected twelve unregistered dogs in the town site with the assistance of the WISH Dog Rescue Foundation. These dogs were collected as a result of not being microchipped and registered, as required by the Shire of Mount Magnet. It is important to note that all of these recently collected dogs have been relocated and rehomed in foster care by the WISH Dog Rescue Foundation in the Perth metropolitan area.

Council will continue conducting the random collection of unregistered dogs in the town site together with the assistance of the WISH Dog Rescue Foundation and its contracted Ranger service. The intention being, to remove as many unregistered dogs in the town site as possible. Therefore all owners of any unregistered dogs are requested to microchip and register their dogs with the Shire of Mount Magnet as soon as possible.

In October 2018 Council partnered with Murdoch University to provide a free de-sexing and microchipping service for the community and importantly the WISH Dog Rescue Foundation can also provide this service free to the owners of unregistered dogs in the community. An advertisement for the WISH Dog Rescue Foundation will appear regularly in future editions of Council Comments.
